CIVIL WAR GRAFFITI AND ART FROM PRINCE WILLIAM COURT RECORDS

The Prince William County Clerk's Office suffered severely in the American Civil War. Numerous record books disappeared or were mutilated by vandals during the Federal occupation. Some of the books that have found their way back to the court house contain interesting inscriptions and illustrations testifying to that time of trial. Here are a few of their stories. Images reproduced courtesy of the Clerk of the Circuit Court.



Picture yourself in the middle of the Civil War. You have been marching for days, fighting skirmishes, and battling hunger, disease and homesickness. A court house and clerk's office have been abandoned and numerous court record books are strewn around. One of your fellow soldiers picks up a book and thumbs through the pages. He announces "Hey, this one has your name in it!"

Another soldier thinks of the hated Secessionist soldiers and angrily uses his bayonet to spear a book. A few more soldiers eager for souvenirs or any reading material grab a few books and return to their camp. Somehow a fire starts and soon the court house is in flames. Many of the books are pulled from the fire but some are lost forever.¹

Later, perhaps sitting around a campfire or resting before another call to strike tents, you pull out this great volume and draw a picture reminiscent of things you have seen or perhaps you simply sign your name and those of your loved ones. All of these things have been found in the Prince William County, Virginia, court record books that survived the Civil War.

At the start of the Civil War Prince William County's Court House was located in Brentsville, Virginia, a town about 3 miles south east of Bristow Station and about 5 miles south of the

Manassas Junction. By 1863 the court house and clerk's office were abandoned and many of the court records were left lying on the floor. Bristow Station was a good camp site for the Union troops and was occupied by first one regiment then another throughout 1863. Being close by, Union troops were often sent to Brentsville to gather building materials and supplies for their camp.²

Historians owe a debt of gratitude to the members of the 145th Pennsylvania Volunteer Infantry for removing at least one court record book from a burning building. An unknown soldier penned this information on the title page of the Dumfries District Court Record in June of 1863. "Rescued from the flames of the burning building by the 145th P. Vs. June 1863".³ The 145th Pennsylvania was moving north to Gettysburg after having fought at Chancellorsville, Virginia, in the spring of 1863 and would have marched through Prince William County on its way.⁴ The 119th New York Infantry passed through as well on its way from Chancellorsville and then returned to Manassas Junction to guard the Orange and Alexandria Railroad from July through September of 1863.⁵ August Drechsler and Patrick Daly of the 119th New York left behind their signatures.⁶

Andrus H. Holcomb of Company Battery L, 1st Light Artillery, New York, may have been feeling particularly homesick when he signed his name in the Prince William County Order Book 1778-1784. He also penned his hometown of Webster, Monroe County, New York, and the name of his father Rev. Chester Holcomb and Electra Jane McKee, his future bride.⁷




Figure 3 – Warning from William F. Keys to all Confederates named Keys. Minutes Book 1834-1861, Prince William County Court Archives.

One of the most interesting volumes to survive the war is the Minute Book 1834-1861, records of the Prince William Circuit Court. The last official entry is of a jury selection for Monday, Oct 14, 1861 in which Jno. Keys is selected as a juror. Immediately after this entry is a note written by William F. Keys of Company K, 143rd Regiment Pennsylvania Volunteers. "John Keys and Walter Keys and all the rest of you Keys - if you are any relations of mine you had better keep shady at least til this cruel war is over. W. F. Keys Co. K 143d P. V." (See figure 3.) William F. Keys was a teacher from Lycoming County, Pennsylvania, before enlisting with the 143rd Pa. Volunteers. His unit fought at Bristoe Station in October of 1863 and also guarded the railroad at Manassas Junction from November 25 to December 5, 1863.

Turning the pages of the Minute Book 1834-1861, one finds a cut through several pages where a bayonet was thrust. On the end pages in back of the book are three drawings and a watercolor picture by unknown artists. (See figures 4-7.) The drawings bring to mind the cruelties of war and the desire for peace.

In October 9-22, 1863 the 2nd Rhode Island Infantry Regiment was also involved in the battle at Bristoe Station. Two soldiers of Company D, Charles S. Nichols and Lindsay Anderson, Esq., then camped at Bristoe Station, signed the Prince William Order Book 1761-63.⁸ Lindsay Anderson was born in Scotland and enlisted on the first of August 1861. He served in the Union Army for three years, transferring to Company A of the 2nd Regt. R.I. in June of 1864.⁹ Anderson later became an owner of a restaurant in Providence, Rhode Island.



“This is the record of the County Court of Prince William County, Va. 1769, found in the deserted camp of a Pa Regt. by the 140th Regt. NY Vols. Presented to A. E. Harmon by his brother Capt. B. F. Harmon 140 NY Vols. Jan 7, 1864.” This is the inscription on the first page of the *County Court Record 1769-71 Prince William County, Va.* How the court volume came to be in a deserted Pennsylvania camp is not known. It is known, that in the fall of 1863 the

140th New York Volunteers were involved in many campaigns around Warrenton and Bristoe Station, Va. The 140th New York set up winter camp at Warrenton Junction but they were also given the task of patrolling the Orange & Alexandria Railroad between Brandy Station and Fairfax. At some point Benjamin Franklin Harmon, the captain of Company F, came into possession of the court record book. As Christmas approached some of the officers were given leave to return home.¹⁰

Augustus E. Harmon, the brother of Capt. B. F. Harmon, was a lawyer living in Champaign, Illinois. He and his family had moved from New York to Illinois in 1860 where his daughter Ada D. Harmon was born.¹¹ A week after New Year's Day 1864, Capt. Benjamin Franklin Harmon presented his war souvenir to his brother Augustus E. Harmon.

The 1769 Prince William County Court Record Book was kept in the Harmon family, passing to Augustus' daughter Ada and then to Clarence Freeto of River Forest, Illinois. In June of 1984 the Freeto family returned the book to the Clerk of the Circuit Court. One hundred and twenty years after leaving Prince William County the *County Court Record, Prince William County, Va., 1769-71*, returned home.

This book "County Court Record, Prince William County, Va., 1769 - 71" was presented to Charlton E. Gnadt, Clerk of the Circuit Court on this 18th day of June, 1984, by the CLARENCE FREETO Family of River Forest, Illinois, in memory of Miss Ada Douglas Harmon.

BRITISH MERCANTILE CLAIMS, 1775-1803
Claims relating to Prince William County Customers and/or Residents

The properties of many British merchants operating in Virginia were confiscated during the Revolutionary War. Virginians often refused to pay debts that were owed to those stores. The peace treaty with Britain, 1783, allowed the merchants to sue in American courts for recovery of these debts. Beginning about 1800, special agents investigated persons owing the debts to determine their current status.

In a long series of articles published between 1962 and 1989 in *The Virginia Genealogist*, John Frederick Dorman prepared abstracts of British Mercantile Claims for the state of Virginia. Following is an index of persons who appear in those reports who were customers of Prince William firms, or were identified as Prince William residents at the beginning of the war.

Data extracted includes the customer's name, estimated date of death (if deceased), date the debt was due, current status of the debt (outcome), citation from *The Virginia Genealogist*, and the name of the creditor. For additional information, please see Mr. Dorman's abstracts which cite particular documents in the Public Record Office, London. DW

Compiler's notes on developing this Index of the articles that appeared in *The Virginia Genealogist*:

1. Death dates were estimated by subtracting from the date of the report if known otherwise by subtracting from 1803, the latest date of the reports.
2. The term "then solvent" refers to being solvent at the time of death.
3. To facilitate search, multi-owner debtor company names are listed under the name of each owner and will therefore appear more than once in this index.
4. Square brackets "[]" reflect comments of the compiler.
5. See each *Virginia Genealogist* citation for reference to the original Treasury Papers series.

Did You Know?

Robert E. Lee's grandfather was removed as a member of the Virginia General Assembly because of election irregularities. Henry Lee II of "Leesylvania" in Prince William County (1729-1787) became a member of the House of Burgesses in 1756, but was challenged by another candidate, Henry Peyton. On Mar. 29, 1756, Peyton complained to the House of "an undue Election and Return." Two days later, an investigative committee reported that Lee had appeared before them and "acknowledged, that he had treated the Freeholders of the said County, to engage their Votes". Apparently he had offered illegal bribes. The House voted to remove him from office.¹² Undaunted, he was reelected in 1758 and remained in office until 1776.¹³

POLL TAX LISTS FOR PRINCE WILLIAM COUNTY, VIRGINIA GAINESVILLE DISTRICT, INCLUDING HAYMARKET (1940s)

Transcribed by Beverly R. Veness

Copies of the 1940s poll tax lists for Prince William County are kept in the manuscript holdings at RELIC. A photocopy of the lists has been made and bound. The bound copy can be found at VA 929.5273 Pri in RELIC. The listings give the person's name with a record of which of the previous three years' taxes were paid; thus the list in 1944 includes the fees paid for 1941-1944. The lists for 1944-1949 have been combined and provide a "census" of those who had paid their poll tax between 1941 and 1949.

Reported districts in the Poll Tax Lists for Prince William County are Brentsville (*Prince William Reliquary*, vol. 1, no. 2), Coles (*Prince William Reliquary*, vol. 1, no. 3), Dumfries including Quantico Town (*Prince William Reliquary*, vol. 1, no. 4), Manassas District (*Prince William Reliquary*, vol. 2, no. 1) and Town of Manassas (*Prince William Reliquary*, vol. 2, no. 2), Occoquan District & Town (*Prince William Reliquary*, vol. 2, no. 3) and Gainesville (*this issue*). The following transcription of Gainesville District ends this series.

If you see two middle initials indicated by a "or", it means recorded one year was one initial and on another year a different initial. It is unknown which one is a typo so I have left it in. All variant spellings of names have been recorded as well as any names added or crossed off.

INDEX TO AGRICULTURAL SCHEDULE PRINCE WILLIAM COUNTY, VA. 1880

Transcribed by Beverly R. Veness

The 1880 index to the Agricultural Schedule for Prince William County, Virginia, includes the first eight columns out of a total of 100 columns.

New information not contained on previous agricultural schedules: Improved Acreage is subdivided with an extra column (see explanation below). There is a section for the cost of building and repairing fences in 1879. Cost of fertilizers. Labor: an extra column for weeks you hired labor in 1879 upon farm (and dairy) excluding housework. Grass lands mown and not mown. More extensive information is given about livestock than previously. With regards to cattle: how many were purchased, sold living, slaughtered, died, strayed, not recovered and calves dropped. Sheep questions: sheep on hand; lambs dropped, purchased, sold living, slaughtered, killed by dogs, died of disease, died of stress of weather, clipped in Spring 1880; number of fleeces and the fleeces weight. Poultry are now counted as well as eggs produced. "Broom Corn" is counted along with "Indian Corn." Orchard fruit is broken down into acres, bearing trees and bushels for apples and peaches. If you had a nursery, it is asked how many acres and the value of produce. There is a section asking about vineyards: acres, grapes sold and wine made. Forest Products lists amount of wood cut and value of forest products sold or consumed.

Farms nearly doubled in 1880 compared to the 1870 agricultural schedule in Prince William County. Comparing the agricultural schedules for census years, there were 605 farms reported in 1850, 582 farms in 1860, 575 farms in 1870 and approximately 1118 farms in 1880.

This index has been divided by the transcriber into two parts: upper Prince William County, in this issue, contains the districts of Brentsville, Manassas and Gainesville. The lower portion of Prince William County contains the districts of Coles, Dumfries and Occoquan. The lower portion will be published in the next issue of *Prince William Reliquary*.

Column one gives name of the person who conducts the farm. The next three columns specify if this person is the owner, rents for a fixed money rental or rents for shares of the products. The next four columns report on acres of land. Under the heading of improved acres, column five is for acres of tilled, including fallow and grass in rotation (whether pasture or meadow) and column six is for permanent meadows, permanent pastures, orchards, or vineyards. Under the heading of unimproved acreage, column seven is for acres of woodland and forest and column eight reports on other unimproved land, including "old fields" not growing wood. Page numbers and line number with their district name abbreviation follows the transcribed columns.

This Agricultural Schedule was very difficult to read in some sections. Using other contemporary sources I have made my best guess as to the names and acreages reported. I advise anyone to double-check my work by referring to the microfilm. Names shown here with a line drawn through were also crossed out on the original schedule. Clarifications or comments were made by the enumerator on some entries. Those comments, often difficult to read, are omitted; I have marked those names with an asterisk (*).

Previous indexes to the Agricultural Schedules for Prince William County and a listing of columns for 1850 can be found in vol. 1, no. 1 of *Prince William Reliquary*. The 1860 index to the Agricultural Schedule can be found in vol. 1, no. 2. and the 1870 index to the Agricultural Schedule is in vol. 1, no. 3.

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No one shall be entitled to the use of the line for more than five consecutive minutes, especially when it is known that some one else is waiting the use of it.

Do not ring without first listening and calling to know if the line is in use; if it is, then wait for five minutes and request the use of the line.

After using the line, do not neglect to "ring off," which is the duty of the one calling.

Persons sending messages, and requiring them to be delivered, must pay actual cost (if any) of delivery. Messages over the phone are private, and should be so regarded.

No improper language will be allowed over the line. For violation of this section there shall be imposed a fine of one (\$1.00) dollar for the first offense, and for a second the matter shall be brought before a committee of three members of the company, appointed by the President, which shall have the power to censure the offender from the use of the line, and in addition thereto, may impose a fine of two (\$2.00) dollars. The party grieved shall have the right to appeal.

When one party calls up another, and asks to communicate with a third party, the one calling shall state his or her identity, or what phone is being used, otherwise the request will not be granted.

Any one through curiosity listening to conversation over the line, is respectfully requested to keep

the battery cut off, otherwise those using the line will be disturbed.

Vocal or instrumental music, or disturbing noises of any kind will not be tolerated during business hours, namely between 6 a. m. and 9 p. m., week days.

It is the desire and intention of this Company to give its patrons courteous treatment and good service; and it is earnestly requested that owners of public and private phones see that the rules and regulations are properly enforced.

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A non-subscriber has no right to use the line free of charge.

Do not use your phone during thunder storm; it is dangerous.

Answer your phone promptly, if good service is expected.

Never use line when others are talking on it.

Let phone-holders and switch-board operators alike extend to each other due respect and forbearance with courtesy.

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
