

The main duties of a crossing guard include safely crossing children walking to and from school within school walk zones and facilitating traffic movement safely through intersections - traffic direction training provided!

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- At least 18 years of age
- High School Diploma or equivalent
- Legally eligible for employment in the United States

BENEFITS

- All part-time employees may enroll in County sponsored benefits and retirement
- Accrue annual, sick, and personal leave
- Paid holidays
- Paid training
- Uniforms provided

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

- Must satisfactorily complete in-house field training
- Must possess valid driver's license
- Must be proficient in the operation of motor vehicles and have suitable driving record
- Pass DMV record check, background investigation, credit check, employment physical and hearing and vision screening

POSITION FAQs

What is the daily work schedule?

Crossings fall between the hours of 7:00 – 9:20 a.m. and 2:00 – 4:20 p.m., Monday – Friday, when school is in session. You must be available to work morning and afternoon crossings.

How are crossing guards paid?

Starting hourly rate is \$17.99. Crossing guards are paid 3 hrs./day (1.5 morning/1.5 afternoon), 15 hrs./wk., and 30 hrs. bi-weekly.

Are crossing guards paid for snow days, teacher's workdays, and holidays?

Crossing guards receive 3 hours per snow day and are not paid for teacher workdays or breaks. Certain holidays are paid.

Can crossing guards earn additional hours?

Crossing guards are compensated for meetings, other work-related errands, and have opportunities to take on any additional crossing when available.

Is there an opportunity for promotion?

This is a part-time position with minimal opportunity for promotion.

Are crossing guards permitted to be employed outside of the Crossing Guard Unit?

Yes, provided the position schedule does not interfere with the crossing schedule and the job is within respectable boundaries.

Do I pay for uniforms?

Uniforms and all equipment are provided.

What is involved in training?

Crossing guards receive 2 weeks of paid classroom training – typically in the mornings and field training at active crossings.
