#### IV. Housing Board Update

The Chairman, Elijah Johnson provided the Housing Board update.

- The Office of Housing is collaborating with Community Services and Department of Behavioral Health Development Services (DBHDS) to administer 72 State Permanent Supportive Housing Vouchers for individuals with serious mental illness. The grant includes housing, case management, and supportive services, with involvement from Community Services, CoC, and non-profit partners. The Notice of Funding Opportunities (NOFO) has not yet been released.
- The Mainstream Voucher Program waiting list has been opened and 100 applicants will be selected through a lottery that meets the eligibility requirements of a non-elderly person with a disability.
- The Office Housing will be launching its HOME ARP Program that will serve approximately 22 homeless individuals/families for more than 5 years.
- The panhandling project will allow non-profit CoC partners to serve homeless individuals and offer employment opportunities.
- The toolkit is forthcoming for non-profit CoC partners to facilitate community donations to organizations serving the homeless population.
