- **Discussed Noise Ordinance Draft Timeline**
- **DCOAG Members addressed concerns about the new Noise Ordinance retroactively to existing and planned data centers.**
 - Wade clarified changes made to the Noise Ordinance will become effective when the Board approves the Ordinance. There are times when the Board will approve an Ordinance and make it effective 30, 60, or 90 days later. When the new Ordinance is deemed effective there aren't grandfathering standards. This is unlike the County Zoning Ordinance or Design and Construction Standards Manual, which has grandfathering for structures already built or plans under review. This is why it's important to understand how the Noise Ordinance will impact schools, hospitals, restaurants, etc. since they will immediately fall under the new Ordinance.
