Updates

Armed Robbery | Carjacking *ARREST- The suspect sought in connection with the robbery that was reported to have occurred at Hendrick Honda, located at 14201 Richmond Hwy in Woodbridge (22191) on July 1, has been arrested. On July 10, the accused, identified as Robert Hampton **BENBOW**, was taken into custody by Alexandria City police.

Armed Robbery [Previously Released]- On July 1 at 3:44AM, officers responded to Hendrick Honda, located at 14201 Richmond Hwy in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a robbery. The investigation revealed the victim, a 44-year-old man, was delivering vehicles to the dealership when an unknown man took the keys to a white Dodge Ram 2500 and entered the vehicle. During the encounter, the suspect brandished a firearm at the victim, before leaving the area in the vehicle. No injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a black male, 30-40 years old, thin build, bald with a goatee, and wearing a white t-shirt.

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Incidents

Fatal Crash Investigation- On July 10 at 6:31AM, officers responded to the Occoquan Commuter Lot located at 1325 Old Bridge Rd in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a crash involving a pedestrian. The investigation revealed a 78-year-old man was attempting to cross the Gordon Blvd entry/exit lanes of the commuter lot when he was struck by a motorist driving a 2020 Jeep Grand Cherokee that was attempting to exit the commuter lot. At the time of the crash, the pedestrian was not in a designated crosswalk. The driver of the Jeep Grand Cherokee, identified as a 42-year-old woman, stayed at the scene and was not injured. The pedestrian was transported to an area hospital and died from his injuries. Crash investigators are asking anyone who may have witnessed this crash to contact police.

Death Investigation- On July 11 at 4:43PM, officers responded to Montclair Family Restaurant, located at 17001 Dumfries Rd in Dumfries (22026) to investigate a report of an unconscious individual. The investigation revealed an employee of the business, a 70-year-old woman, collapsed and was found unconscious by her co-workers. The woman was pronounced dead on scene. Preliminarily, there were no signs of foul play or threat to the community concerning the death. More information regarding the investigation will be released if deemed necessary.

Shooting Investigation- On July 11, officers responded to investigate a shooting that was reported to have occurred at an unknown location in Woodbridge on July 10 at 11:20PM. The investigation revealed a 25-year-old man was attending a party at a residence in Woodbridge when he was struck in the foot by gunfire. The man was transported to an area hospital for treatment and was not forthcoming with additional information as to what led up to the shooting. No suspect information could be provided.

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On July 12, officers responded to the 14100 block of Crossing Pl in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a report of shots fired. The investigation revealed during an unknown timeframe, gunshots were fired in the parking lot at the above location. Officers located multiple shell casings in the area. No property damage or injuries were reported.

Commercial Burglary- On July 11 at 5:38AM, officers responded to Mi Tierra Deli Restauant, located at 14120 Jefferson Davis Hwy in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate an alarm activation. The investigation revealed an unknown man shattered the front entryway glass window and entered the business. The suspect removed an undisclosed amount of money from a tip jar, before leaving the area on foot. A police K-9 searched the area for the suspect who were not located. The suspect was described as a black male, age 35-45 years, wearing a green t-shirt, green camouflage-patterned cargo shorts, black shoes and a black hat.



Arrests

Armed Robbery- On July 10, Officers responded to the 12700 block of Harbor Dr in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a robbery that was reported to have occurred at approximately 1:54PM that day. The investigation revealed the victim, a 17-year-old male juvenile, had arranged to meet an unknown individual, later identified as the accused, in the above area to sell a watch. During the encounter, the accused brandished a firearm and demanded the accused give him an undisclosed amount of money, before leaving the area in a vehicle. No injuries were reported. Following the investigation, officers obtained charges and the accused, identified as a **17-year-old male juvenile**, was arrested.

Assault and Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]- On July 12 at 1048PM, officers responded to a residence located in the 10200 block of Irongate Wy in Manassas (20109) to investigate an assault. During the investigation, officers detained one of the parties involved, later identified as the accused. While escorting the accused to a police cruiser, the accused became aggressive and kicked an officer in the leg. No injuries were reported by the officer. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Erick Edgardo **ESCALENTE MELGAR**, was arrested.
