Incidents

Sexual Assault Investigation- On July 11, officers responded to investigate a sexual assault that was reported to have occurred at the Walmart located at 9401 Liberia Ave in Manassas (20110) at 6:30PM that evening. The investigation revealed the victim, a 51-year-old woman, was in the store when she was approached by an unknown man. During the encounter, the suspect inappropriately touched the victim, then showed her obscene material on his phone, before leaving the area. No injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a Hispanic male wearing a blue shirt, grey shorts and grey shoes.

Commercial Burglary- On July 13, officers responded to a mechanic shop located in the 8100 block of Leland Rd in Manassas (20111) to investigate a burglary. The investigation revealed sometime overnight, the latch to the front door was damaged and multiple tools were reported stolen. No suspect description was available.

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Arrests

Burglary Investigation- On July 11 at 9:30AM, officers responded to a residence located in the 2600 block of Logmill Rd in Haymarket (20169) to investigate a suspicious person. The investigation revealed an unknown man operating a stolen vehicle attempted to break into the residence, then rummaged through an unoccupied vehicle before vandalizing another vehicle that was parked at a neighboring residence. The accused then drove to the Evergreen Volunteer Fire Department and Rescue Squad located at 3510 James Madison Hwy and entered the station before stealing a fire department shirt and leaving the area in the vehicle. Later that day, the accused was taken into custody by Fauquier County deputies for additional offenses committed in their jurisdiction. Following the investigation, officers obtained arrest warrants and the accused, identified as Matthew Dean **LEDBETTER**, was arrested.
