Updates

Fatal Crash Investigation *DRIVER CHARGED – On July 15, crash investigators obtained a court summons for a traffic violation citing the driver of the 2020 Jeep Grand Cherokee in the fatal collision involving a pedestrian that occurred at the Occoquan Commuter Lot located at 1325 Old Bridge Rd in Woodbridge (22192) on July 10. The investigation revealed the driver of the vehicle, identified as the accused, failed to stop at a stop sign, which contributed to the collision that killed a 78-year-old man that was crossing the entry/exit lanes of the commuter lot. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Arlen Yessenia **VIVAS PEREZ**, was charged.

Fatal Crash Investigation [Previously Released] – On July 10 at 6:31AM, officers responded to the Occoquan Commuter Lot located at 1325 Old Bridge Rd in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a crash involving a pedestrian. The investigation revealed a 78-year-old man was attempting to cross the Gordon Blvd entry/exit lanes of the commuter lot when he was struck by a motorist driving a 2020 Jeep Grand Cherokee that was attempting to exit the commuter lot. At the time of the crash, the pedestrian was not in a designated crosswalk. The driver of the Jeep Grand Cherokee stayed at the scene and was not injured. The pedestrian was transported to an area hospital and died from his injuries. **Crash investigators are asking anyone who may have witnessed this crash to contact police.**

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Arrests

Strong-Armed Robbery- On July 15, officers responded to investigate a robbery that was reported to have occurred in the 13000 block of Telegraph Rd in Woodbridge (22192) at 4:10PM that afternoon. The investigation revealed the victim, a 12-year-old boy, was riding his E-bike in the area when he was approached by three unknown male juveniles. During the encounter, the suspects assaulted the victim and took his E-bike before leaving the area. Minor injuries were reported by the victim. Officers located one of the suspects, identified as the accused, a short time later and detained him. Following the investigation the accused, identified as a **17-year-old male juvenile**, was arrested. The investigation into the identity of the two suspects is ongoing.
