Incidents

Death Investigation- On July 16 at 7:13PM, officers responded to the area of Pageland Ln and Groveton Rd in Manassas (20109) to investigate a death. The investigation revealed the deceased, identified as a 30-year-old man, was located along a wooded trail in the above area with an apparent self-inflicted injury. The man was pronounced dead on scene. Preliminarily, there were no signs of foul play concerning the death. More information regarding the investigation will be released if deemed necessary.

Malicious Wounding- On July 15 at 10:57PM, officers responded to El Pulgarcito restaurant, located at 1306 Horner Rd in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate an assault. The investigation revealed the victim, a 39-year-old man and an acquaintance became involved in a physical altercation with two unknown men. During the encounter, the victim was struck in the upper body with a glass bottle. The victim sustained injuries and was transported to an area hospital for treatment. The suspects were described as two Hispanic men.

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On July 16, officers responded to the 10900 block of Burwell Rd in Nokesville (20181) to investigate a report of shots fired. The investigation revealed that at approximately 3:30AM that morning, multiple gunshots were heard in the area, and an unoccupied vehicle and mailbox were later found to be struck by gunfire. Officers located multiple shell casings in the roadway. No injuries or additional property damage were reported.

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Arrests

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On July 15, officers responded to a residence located in the 10900 block of Wild Ginger Cir in Manassas (20109) to investigate a report of shots fired. The investigation revealed that at approximately 12:00PM that afternoon an individual, later identified as the accused, was cleaning her residence when her firearm fell from a piece of furniture and discharged, striking a neighboring residence. No injuries or additional property damage were reported. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Jacky Stephany **ROMERO MARTINEZ**, was charged.
