Incidents

Fatal Crash Investigation- On August 27 at 2:25PM, officers responded to the intersection of Dominion Valley Dr and Waverly Farm Dr in Haymarket (20169) to investigate a crash. The investigation revealed the driver of a 2022 Honda Civic was traveling on Waverly Farm Dr approaching Dominion Valley Dr. The driver ran the stop sign at the intersection and struck a tree, causing the vehicle to roll and strike a second tree, before ultimately coming to rest against a fenceline. The driver, an 18-year-old man, was transported to an area hospital and was later pronounced deceased as a result of injuries sustained in the crash, on August 29. Speed is believed to be a factor in this crash. **Crash investigators are asking anyone with information or anyone who may have witnessed the crash, to contact police.**

Armed Robbery- On August 29 at 9:19PM, officers responded to the AutoZone located at 12409 Cape Cod Ct in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a robbery. The investigation revealed an unknown man entered the store and took multiple items of merchandise. During the encounter, the suspect brandished a firearm at an employee, before leaving the area on foot. No injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a black male, aged 16-25 years, 5'10", slim build, wearing black clothing.

Brandishing- On August 28, officers responded to investigate a brandishing that was reported to have occurred at the intersection of Richmond Hwy and Prince William Pkwy in Woodbridge (22191) at 8:41AM that morning. The investigation revealed the victim, a 37-year-old man, was driving on Richmond Hwy when he changed lanes near the driver of a Toyota Prius. The other driver then followed the victim and brandished a firearm, before leaving the area in the vehicle. No shots were fired and no injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a Hispanic male with curly hair.

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On August 28 at 10:21PM, officers responded to the 16500 block of Royal Ct in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a report of shots fired. The investigation revealed multiple gunshots were heard and a residence was struck by gunfire. Officers located multiple shell casings in the area. No injuries or additional property damage were reported. No suspect information was available

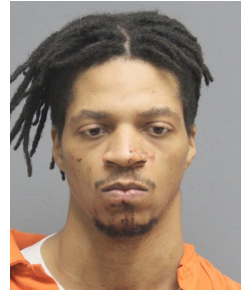

Arrests

Homicide Investigation – On August 30 at 6:12AM, officers responded to a residence located in the 4600 block of Whitaker Pl in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a domestic dispute resulting in a stabbing. Arriving officers quickly located the victim inside the home with stab wounds to the upper body and immediately rendered aid. The victim, a 27-year-old man, was transported to an area hospital where he later died. The investigation revealed the victim and a family member, identified as the accused, were involved in an altercation that escalated. During the encounter, the accused produced a knife and stabbed the victim multiple times in the upper body. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Ryheim Darnel **HARRINGTON**, was arrested at the residence without incident. **Detectives are asking anyone with any information, or anyone who may have witnessed the incident, to contact police.**



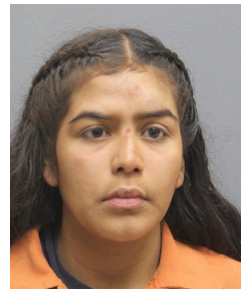

Assault and Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]- On August 30 at 7:38PM, officers were working an event at the Prince William County Fairgrounds located at 10624 Dumfries Rd in Manassas (20112) when they responded to investigate a report of a disorderly individual. The investigation revealed the individual, later identified as the accused, was intoxicated and was acting aggressive towards staff before she bit a staff member as she was being escorted out of the venue. Officers detained the accused and while being handcuffed, the accused continued to be aggressive and bit an officer before being secured. Minor injuries were reported by the officer. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Daira Zuleika **LUNA**, was arrested.

Assault and Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]- On August 29, officers responded to a residence located in the 15700 block of Cranberry Ct in Dumfries (22025) to investigate a report of child neglect. The investigation revealed on August 28 at approximately 7:00PM, a woman, identified as the accused, left her 1-year-old child and two juvenile nephews without adult supervision and in deplorable living conditions in order to attend an event. When the accused returned home the next morning, she was placed under arrest by officers. While being seated in a police cruiser, the accused attempted to flee and became aggressive, assaulting officers multiple times before being secured. Minor injuries were reported by one of the officers. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Genea Samantha **KING**, was arrested.
