Incidents

Armed Robbery- On August 31 at 4:20PM, officers responded to the CVS located at 13600 Richmond Hwy in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a robbery. The investigation revealed an unknown man entered the store and attempted to buy a lighter. During the encounter, the suspect jumped over the counter, produced a box cutter and an aerosol can and threatened two employees. The suspect then took the lighter and left the area on foot. No injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a Hispanic male wearing blue jeans, a black t-shirt and black shoes.



Indecent Exposure- On August 31, officers responded to Target located at 4310 Fortuna Center Plz in Dumfries (22025) to investigate a report of an indecent exposure. The investigation revealed at approximately 2:55PM, the victim, a 15-year-old female juvenile, was with acquaintances when she observed an unknown man in the store. During the encounter, the suspect followed the victim, exposed himself and made obscene gestures, before leaving the area. No physical contact occurred and no injuries were reported.

Residential Burglary- On August 29, officers responded to a residence located in the 4900 block of Kirwyn Ct in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a burglary that was reported to have occurred at 10:20AM that morning. The investigation revealed an unknown man entered through an open garage door and took two power tools, before leaving the area on foot. No damage to property was reported. The suspect was described as a black male with short dread locks, a moustache and goatee, wearing a dark gray "Modelo" t-shirt, tan shorts, white shoes and a black and gray wrist sleeve.

Commercial Burglary- On August 31, officers responded to Prince William Water located at 8151 Piney Branch Ln in Bristow (21036) to investigate a reported burglary. The investigation revealed sometime overnight, a fence had been cut and copper wire, tools and lumber were reported missing. No suspect description was available.

Arrests

Brandishing- On August 30, officers responded to investigate a brandishing that was reported to have occurred at the Sheetz located at 5350 Dale Blvd in Woodbridge (22193) at 2:29PM that afternoon. The investigation revealed the victim, a 42-year-old man, was approached in the parking lot by an unknown man, later identified as the accused. During the encounter, the parties got into a verbal argument and the accused lifted his shirt and displayed a firearm before leaving the area in a vehicle. Officers quickly located the vehicle and following the investigation, the accused, identified as Deaundray Travais **MCALLISTER**, was arrested.
