Updates

Indecent Exposure *ARREST- On September 1, the suspect sought in connection to the indecent exposure that was reported to have occurred at Target, located at 4310 Fortuna Plz in Dumfries (22025) on August 31 was arrested. Officers located the accused, identified as Joel Robert **STEVENSON**, and took him into custody at his residence in Manassas.

Indecent Exposure [Previously Released]- On August 31, officers responded to Target located at 4310 Fortuna Center Plz in Dumfries (22025) to investigate a report of an indecent exposure. The investigation revealed at approximately 2:55PM, the victim, a 15-year-old female juvenile, was with acquaintances when she observed an unknown man in the store. During the encounter, the suspect followed the victim, exposed himself and made obscene gestures, before leaving the area. No physical contact occurred and no injuries were reported.

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Incidents

Reckless Handling of a Firearm Incidents- On August 31 at 3:00AM, officers responded to the 11000 block of Hiram Ct in Manassas (20109) to investigate a report of shots fired. The investigation revealed multiple gunshots were heard and a total of three residences and six vehicles were struck by gunfire. This incident is believed to be related to additional property damage calls that were reported later that day on August 31 and on September 1. The investigation into those incidents revealed a home and a vehicle in the 7500 block of Clemson Ct, a home in the 11000 block of Hiram Ct and a home in the 7500 block of Willoughby Ln were struck by gunfire, possibly related to the previously reported incident. No injuries were reported in any of the incidents. No shell casings were located. The suspect was described as a male wearing dark clothing, leaving the area in a light-colored sedan.

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On September 1, officers responded to the 12600 block of Homestead Dr in Nokesville (20181) to investigate a report of shots fired. The investigation revealed on August 31 between 9:30PM and 10:00PM, multiple gunshots were heard in the area. Multiple shell casings were located on Kettle Run Rd. No injuries or damage to property were reported.

Commercial Burglary- On September 1, officers responded to Prince William Water, located at 8151 Piney Branch Ln in Bristow (20136) to investigate a reported burglary. The investigation revealed between August 31 at 2:30PM and September 1 at 6:30AM, a fence on the property had been cut and copper wire, various power tools and electrical supplies were reported missing. No suspect description was available.

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Arrests

Malicious Wounding- On August 30 at 8:45PM, officers were working an event at the Prince William County Fairgrounds located at 10624 Dumfries Rd in Manassas (20112) when they responded to investigate a report of an assault. The investigation revealed the two victims, a 31-year-old man and a 33-year-old man, were attending the event when they got into a verbal argument with a group of unknown men. During the encounter, the argument escalated and two of men, later identified as the two accused, struck the victims with their belt buckles. The victims sustained injuries and were treated on scene by my medics. Following the investigation, the two accused, identified as Yoan **VASQUEZ LOZANA** and Jorge **RANGEL PALACIOS** were arrested.

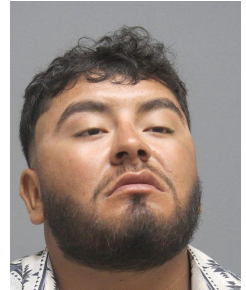

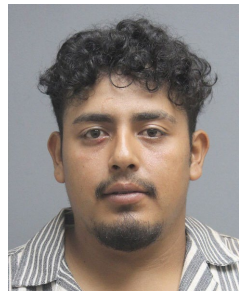

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Assault and Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]- On September 1 at 11:10PM, officers responded to the Queens Gambit, located at 12730 Black Forest Ln in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate an assault. The investigation revealed a patron, later identified as the accused, was intoxicated and assaulted another patron, before being restrained. Officers took the accused into custody and while at the Prince William-Manassas Regional Adult Detention Center, the accused became aggressive, spitting on an officer and attempting to kick the officer, before being secured. No injuries were reported by the officer. Following the investigation the accused, identified as Nicholas James **CARROLL**, was arrested.
