

### Q1. Have you or members of your household visited any Prince William County Parks and Recreation parks or facilities in the past 12 months?








### Q1a. How would you rate the overall physical condition of Prince William County Parks and Recreation parks and facilities that you have visited?

by percentage of respondents who have visited parks or facilities in the past 12 months





### Q3. Which TWO organizations listed in Question 2 does your household USE MOST for parks, trails, sports, and recreation programs and services?



by percentage of respondents (multiple choices could be chosen)








## Q4. Estimated Number of Households that Have a Need for Facilities








### Q4. How Well **Facilities Meet** the Needs to Respondent Households










## Q5. <u>Facilities</u> That Are Most Important to Respondent Households

by percentage of respondents who selected the items as one of their top four choices






















Q8. Which FOUR actions from the list in Question 6 above are MOST IMPORTANT for the County to fund?














## Q9. Estimated Number of Households Whose Needs for Recreation Programs are Being Met 50% or Less








## Q10. Recreation Programs That Are Most Important to Respondent Households






### Q11. Please rate your satisfaction with the overall value your household receives from the Prince William County Parks.






### Q12. Please CHECK ALL the reasons that prevent you or other members of your household from using parks, trails, recreation facilities, or programs of Prince William County Parks more often.






### Q13. Please CHECK ALL the ways you currently learn about parks, trails, programs, and activities of Prince William County parks.




