- The PAR Committee met to review two Community Application submissions for 2019 HUD Application. One or two projects could potentially be submitted as part of the 2019 HUD application: one for Permanent Supportive Housing and one for the DV Bonus.
- Committee members were pretty close in scoring each applicant. Each member of the PAR Committee was in agreement with the final scores.

 - An applicant utilized one application to apply for two grant projects. There should be one application per project.
 - o Required questions were not answered in the application.
 - o Required questions were not thoroughly anwered.
 - The budgets were incomplete.

o Applicant One: 52

o Applicant Two: 34

PAR Committee Recommendation:
