- PAR Committee Recommendations for CoC Bonus Funding Priorities

  LoToya Bass presented the PAR committee recommendation to the CoC. The HUD

  NOFA (Notice of Funding Availability) has not been released at this time, the
  recommendation is in anticipation of the HUD NOFA release based on the content of
  previous years' content. The PAR recommendation is for the potential Permanent
  Housing Bonus to focus solely on Permanent Supportive Housing and Domestic Violence
  project if funding is available. The process and detailing of specific qualifiers and
  definitions were provided to the CoC. A motion to approve the recommendation from
  PAR to focus on PSH as well as DV funding if available in anticipation HUD NOFA is
  released was put forward. 1) Allan Jones, 2) Lynn Fritts, none opposed, NVFS abstained.

- DSS Lead Agency Update
  - Tony Turnage presented the DSS Lead Agency Update on the following matters:
    - ✓ CoC Leadership Part II training is being planned for May and the dates are being finalized.
    - ✓ For the 2019 HUD Application Diana T. Meyers and Associates has been selected as the grant consultant for CoC HUD Applications process.
    - ✓ CoC Grant application "How-To-Apply" sessions are scheduled for April 15, 2019.
    - ✓ The new HMIS Administrator, Alicia La Patra, started on March 25, 2019.
    - ✓ The 2019 PIT numbers were presented to the CoC and handouts were provided.
    - ✓ The 2020 census is an opportunity to work together with street outreach programs to coordinate efforts to count persons in PWA. More information will be sent out as it becomes available.
    - ✓ The CoC annual registration for FY2020 will be released at the next CoC meeting. Registration form will be due to DSS by June 13, 2019.
    - ✓ IT Programming, SA Group, breakfast services by OASIS a local non-profit will be offered twice a month, and Opportunities, Alternatives, and Restoration & Restoration (OAR) will provide onsite services at the Drop-In Center for unsheltered homeless persons.
    - ✓ Coordinated Entry System welcomes a new full time I&R Specialist, Marion Silas to the team. The RRH referral process continues to improve via the weekly conference calls. Homeless Services Staff with the Service Continuum Committee are working to update the CES policies.
    - ✓ Hilda Barg Homeless Prevention Center renovations are coming together and new programming includes onsite mental health services from CSB and onsite employment services from the Skill Source.
    - ✓ The Homeless Services Division is in the process of arranging Boundaries Training for Hilda Barg Residential Assistants that will be facilitated by the NVFS Therapist.
